

Back to School Supplies
for 2020-2021 school year

PRESCHOOL: A backpack, 1" 3 ring binder, one folder, 1 box Crayola Broad Tip Classic Color Markers, 1 box of 24 crayons, 1 pencil box, 6 Elmer's Glue Sticks, 1 Bottle Elmer's Glue, 1 Blunt Tip Scissors, 1 Box of Kleenex, 1 container of Clorox wipes and a set of clothes to be kept in locker. A box of crackers, granola bars, fruit snacks etc. to share for afternoon snack. (Tuition covers morning snack, milk and lunch).

KINDERGARTEN: Box of 24 crayons, box of broad washable markers (fat markers), 5-#2 pencils, 5 pencil top erasers, 1 hard plastic pencil box, school/book bag, take-home folder of your choice, box of Kleenex. 8 glue sticks, 2 bottles school glue, 1-1/2" 3 ring binder, 1 set of headphones (no earbuds) (labeled), 1 USB flash drive (labeled), an extra set of clothing in a large zip top bag and label. 1 box of qt/gallon zip-top baggies. 1 box sandwich size Ziploc bags. **DO NOT LABEL ITEMS UNLESS NOTED. THANK YOU.**

GRADE 1: Box of 200-count tissues for the classroom, 1 box 24 count crayons, backpack (labeled), 24 pencils (sharpened) 1 hard case pencil/crayon storage box (labeled), sock for white board eraser, scissor (labeled), 2 large erasers, 1 red folder, 1 blue folder, 1 4 pk of dry erase markers. 1 set of headphones (no earbuds and labeled) 8 large glue sticks, 1 box of gallon sized baggies (for families with last name A-M), 1 box of sandwich sized baggies (for families with last name N-Z), 3-1 inch 3 ring binder (any color & labeled), 1 labeled spiral bound wide-lined notebook your choice of color, 1 container of Lysol disinfecting wipes, 1 extra set of clothing in a baggie (labeled) to keep in child's locker. **DO NOT LABEL ITEMS UNLESS NOTED. THANK YOU.**

GRADE 2: 24-#2 pencils (not paper wrapped, plain yellow), 1 large eraser, 1 box of 24 crayons, 2 pks colored pencils (8-10 pk), 1 wide-lined spiral notebook, 2 composition notebook, 2 pocket folders, 1 bottle of Elmers glue, 2 large glue sticks, 1 pencil box, 1 box washable markers, scissors, 1 box of **Puffs** Kleenex, back pack, paint shirt, 1 box snack or small Ziploc bags (last names begin with A-K), 1 box large Ziploc bags (for last names that begin with M-Z), 1 container of disinfectant wipes, Set of headphones (if not handed on from last year). No earbuds please! **Snack for milk break. PLEASE LABEL ALL MATERIALS WITH YOUR INITIALS – INCLUDING PENCILS.**

GRADE 3: Box 200-count tissues for classroom, 10-#2 pencils (no mechanicals please), erasers, 3 wide-lined spiral notebooks (1 each red, blue, green), book bag or backpack, 1 bottle Elmer's glue, ruler, 24 crayons, colored pencils, scissors, 3 pocket folders (1 each red, blue green), pencil box, 3 red ink pens for correcting, 2 take-home folders of your choice, 1 box of gallon, snack size or sandwich size Ziploc bags (last name starting with A-K), Clorox wipes (last name starting with L-Z). Headphones in ziploc bag (no ear buds), if not handed on from last year.
Optional: Expo markers, regular markers or highlighters, sweatshirt and snack in a plastic bag.

GRADE 4: Box of 200-count tissues for the classroom, 3 or more #2 pencils, **NO MECHANICAL PENCILS.** Soft erasers, Inexpensive pocket-size calculator, crayons, colored pencils, white school glue, 2 pens, 2 or 3 college- or wide-lined spiral notebooks, 3 pocket folders, inexpensive headphones or earbuds for listening station and computer time (if not handed on from last year) and 2 expo markers any color. **NO TRAPPER KEEPERS, PLEASE!**

GRADE 5: Box of 200-count tissues for the classroom, 5-#2 pencils, soft eraser, crayons, pencil box, 3 college- or wide-lined single subject spiral notebooks, 3 pocket folders (**NO TRAPPER KEEPERS, PLEASE!**) white school glue, 1 Small scissors, inexpensive pocket-size calculator, colored pencils, 1 container Clorox wipes, 3 pens for correcting, 3 Expo Markers, any color. 1 box Ziploc sandwich bags, Inexpensive headphones or earbuds for listening station and computer time.
OPTIONAL: Markers.

GRADE 6: Box of 200-count tissues, 3 or more #2 pencils, pencil box, soft eraser, 5 notebooks, 1 composition notebook, 3 pocket folders or 1 zippered folder, 2 correcting pens, basic calculator, 1 container of Clorox wipes. Optional: please choose one: crayons, markers or colored pencils.
