## Back to School Supplies <br> for 2021-2022 school year

PRESCHOOL: A backpack, 1" 3 ring binder, one folder, 1 box Crayola Broad Tip Classic Color Markers, 1 box of 24 crayons, 1 Bottle Elmer's Glue, 1 Blunt Tip Scissors and a set of clothes to be kept in locker.
