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## Fall 2021 COVID Precaution and Plan for Hancock Public School

At this time, Districts are able to make COVID prevention decisions at a local level. We are excited to begin the school year without many of the restrictions we faced last year. It is imperative that we continue to provide a healthy and safe environment for our students and staff.

### Hancock COVID Plan for 2021-22 School Year

1. Vaccinations – The district will not require vaccinations. The CDC and MDH recommend vaccinations for eligible students and adults.
2. Face Coverings and Physical Distancing – Recommended and optional, will not be required.
3. Quarantine and Isolation – Recommend self-quarantining for positive cases and close contacts.
4. Instructional Plan – In-person for all grade levels with traditional schedule and school calendar.
5. No distance learning option for all grade levels.
6. Lunchroom Protocol – Typical lunch periods, regular student population, all table seats will be available for use at lunch.
7. Regular handwashing and respiratory etiquette will be emphasized.
8. Daily cleaning routine of surfaces.
9. Evaluation of the operational capacity of the districts ventilation system.
10. Staying home when you are ill or have a fever.
11. Communication - Changes in the plan will be conveyed through our school messaging system.
