

**Back to School Supplies**  
**for 2022-2023 school year**

**PRESCHOOL:** A backpack, 1" 3 ring binder, one folder, 1 box Crayola Broad Tip Classic Color Markers, 1 box of 24 crayons, 1 Bottle Elmer's Glue, 8 glue sticks, 1 Blunt Tip Scissors and a set of clothes to be kept in locker. A box of crackers, granola bars, fruit snacks etc. to share for afternoon snack. (Tuition covers morning snack, milk and lunch).

**KINDERGARTEN:** Box of 24 crayons, box of broad washable markers (fat markers), 5-#2 pencils, 5 pencil top erasers, school/book bag, take-home folder of your choice, box of Kleenex. 10 glue sticks, 1 bottle school glue, 1-1/2" 3 ring binder, 1 box of sandwich size Ziploc bags for families with last name beginning with A-J, gallon size Ziploc bags (last name starting with K-Z), 1 set of headphones (no earbuds/bluetooth) (labeled), 1 USB flash drive (labeled), an extra set of clothing in a large zip top bag and label. **DO NOT LABEL ITEMS UNLESS NOTED. THANK YOU.**

**GRADE 1:** Box of 200-count tissues for the classroom, 1 box 24 count crayons, backpack (labeled), 12 pencils (sharpened) 1 hard case pencil/crayon storage box (labeled), scissor (labeled), 2 large erasers, 1 folder, 8 large glue sticks, 1 bottle of Elmer's liquid glue, 1 box of gallon sized baggies (for families with last name A-M), 1 box of sandwich sized baggies (for families with last name N-Z), 2-1 inch 3 ring binder (any color & labeled), 2 labeled spiral bound wide-lined notebook your choice of color, an old sock for white board erasing, 4 pack of dry erase markers, 1 container of Lysol disinfecting wipes, headphones labeled and 1 extra set of clothing in a baggie (labeled) to keep in child's locker. A clear water bottle – labeled. **DO NOT LABEL ITEMS UNLESS NOTED. THANK YOU.**

**GRADE 2:** 24-#2 pencils (not paper wrapped, plain yellow), 2 large erasers, 1 box of 24 crayons, 2 pks colored pencils (8-10 pk), 2 composition notebook, 1 pocket folder, 3 large glue sticks, 1 bottle school glue, 1 pencil box, 2 box washable broadline markers (8-10 pack), scissors, back pack, 1 box of Kleenex, paint shirt, 1 box snack or small or large Ziploc bags (last names begin with A-K), 1 container of Clorox wipes (for last names that begin with L-Z). Set of headphones (if not handed on from last year). No earbuds please! **Optional: Snack for milk break. PLEASE LABEL ALL MATERIALS WITH YOUR INITIALS – INCLUDING PENCILS.**

**GRADE 3:** 10-#2 pencils (no mechanicals please), pencil box, erasers, book bag or backpack, 1 bottle Elmer's glue, 4 glue sticks, 24 crayons, colored pencils, scissors, 3 red ink pens for correcting, 3 take-home folders (one red, one blue, one green), Headphones in ziploc bag (no ear buds), if not handed on from last year, 3 black Expo markers, **Optional: Snacks for snack time.**

**GRADE 4:** Box of 200-count tissues for the classroom, 3 or more #2 pencils, **NO MECHANICAL PENCILS.** Pencil box, soft erasers, Inexpensive pocket-size calculator, crayons, white school glue, 1 college- or wide-lined spiral notebooks, 3 pocket folders, inexpensive headphones or earbuds for listening station and computer time (if not handed on from last year) and 2 expo markers any color. **NO TRAPPER KEEPERS, PLEASE!**

**GRADE 5:** Box of 200-count tissues for the classroom, 5-#2 pencils, soft eraser, crayons, pencil box, 5 college- or wide-lined single subject spiral notebooks, 3 pocket folders (**NO TRAPPER KEEPERS, PLEASE!**) white school glue, inexpensive pocket-size calculator, colored pencils, 1 container Clorox wipes, hand sanitizer, 2 pens for correcting, 2 Expo Markers, any color. Inexpensive headphones or earbuds for listening station and computer time.

**GRADE 6:** Box of 200-count tissues, 3-5 boxes #2 pencils, pencil box, soft eraser, 5 notebooks, 1 composition notebook, 3 pocket folders or 1 zippered folder, 2 correcting pens, basic calculator, headphone for use with computer, 1 container of Clorox wipes. **Optional: please choose one: crayons, markers or colored pencils.**
