# Back to School Supplies 2024-2025 School Year 

PRESCHOOL: A backpack, 1 - 1 inch 3 ring binder, 1 folder, 2 boxes Crayola Broad Tip Classic Color Markers, 1 box of 24 crayons, 8 glue sticks, 1 crayola watercolor paint set, a set of clothes to be kept in locker and a box of crackers, granola bars, fruit snacks etc. to share for afternoon snack.
KINDERGARTEN: Box of 24 crayons, box of broad washable markers (fat markers), 5-\#2 pencils, school/book bag, take-home folder of your choice, box of Kleenex. 10 glue sticks, 1 bottle school glue, One 1-1/2" 3 ring binder, 1 box of sandwich size Ziploc bags for families with last name beginning with A-J, gallon size Ziploc bags (last name starting with K-Z), 1 set of headphones (no earbuds/bluetooth) (labeled), an extra set of clothing in a large zip top bag and label. DO NOT LABEL ITEMS UNLESS NOTED. Extra items if desired: Clorox wipes, extra glue sticks, class snacks such as crackers, fruit snacks, cookies.
GRADE 1: Box of 200-count tissues for the classroom, 1 box 24 count crayons, backpack (labeled), 12 Ticonderoga pencils, 1 hard case pencil/crayon storage box- no locks (labeled), scissor (labeled), 2 folder, 20 small glue sticks, 1 box of gallon sized baggies (for families with last name A-K), 1 box of sandwich sized baggies (for families with last name L-Z), ONE 3 ring binder (any color \& labeled- 1 inch), 2 labeled spiral bound wide-lined notebook your choice of color, 3 container of Lysol disinfecting wipes, headphones labeled and 1 extra set of clothing in a baggie (labeled) to keep in child's locker. DO NOT LABEL ITEMS UNLESS NOTED.
GRADE 2: 24-\#2 pencils (not paper wrapped, plain yellow), 1 large eraser, 1 box of 24 crayons, 2 pks colored pencils ( $8-10 \mathrm{pk}$ ), 1 composition notebook, 1 pocket folder, 5 large glue sticks, 1 pencil box, 2 box washable broadline markers ( $8-10$ pack), scissors, back pack, paint shirt, 4 Expo dry erase markers, sandwich ziploc bags (Last name beginning with A-H), Lysol wipes (last name beginning with J-Z), 1 box Puffs tissues, set of headphones. No earbuds please! Snack for milk break. PLEASE LABEL ALL MATERIALS WITH YOUR INITIALS - INCLUDING PENCILS.
GRADE 3: 20-\#2 pencils (no mechanicals please), pencil box, pencil top erasers, 1 take home folder of choice, book bag or backpack, 4 glue sticks, 24 crayons, colored pencils, scissors, pencil sharpener, 1 single subject notebook, washable coloring markers, 3 folders (one red, one blue, one green), Headphones in ziploc bag (no ear buds), if not handed on from last year, 3 black Expo markers, box of tissues Optional: Snacks for snack time.
GRADE 4: Box of 200-count tissues for the classroom, 2 pens, 12 \#2 pencils, NO MECHANICAL PENCILS. Pencil box, soft erasers, 1 box of 24 crayons, colored pencils 1 college- or wide-lined spiral notebooks, 3 pocket folders, inexpensive headphones or earbuds for listening station and computer time and 2 expo markers of any color.
GRADE 5: 2 Boxes of 200-count tissues for the classroom, 10-\#2 pencils, soft eraser, 1 box of markers, pencil box, 3 college- or wide-lined single subject spiral notebooks, 3 pocket folders, white school glue, 3 glue sticks, colored pencils, 2 permanent markers, scissors, 2 containers Clorox wipes, 2 pens for correcting, 5 Expo Markers (any color), inexpensive headphones or earbuds for listening station and computer time.
GRADE 6: Box of 200-count tissues, 3-5 boxes \#2 pencils, pencil box, soft eraser, 5 notebooks, 1 composition notebook, 3 pocket folders or 1 zippered folder, 2 correcting pens, 2 black sharpies, basic calculator, headphones and mouse for use with computer, 1 container of Clorox wipes.
